## Adopt an Artwork Program for 2018 *Coming Home: Art and the Great Hunger* Exhibition

Ireland's Great Hunger Museum at Quinnipiac University is sending its acclaimed art collection to Ireland in 2018. The exhibition, *Coming Home: Art and the Great Hunger*, will bring the world's largest collection of Famine-related art home to Ireland for one year. 50 pieces from the museum's collection will be making the journey for this major exhibition and will be displayed in Dublin, Skibbereen and Derry.

To assist with professional fine art shipping costs, as well as any conservation needs, the museum has created an Adopt an Artwork program for *Coming Home: Art and the Great Hunger* to connect prospective donors with specific and tangible needs. This program will allow the museum to safely send its acclaimed art collection home to Ireland for display in Dublin Castle, West Cork Arts Centre and Cultúrlann Uí Chanáin in Derry City.

As part of the adoption process, you will receive the following:

- A short dossier on the work you have chosen.
- A print of the piece suitable for framing.
- Invitation to collection send-off party.
- A credit line on the gallery label giving recognition to the adoptive sponsor throughout the exhibition in Dublin, Skibbereen and Derry.
- Recognition on the exhibition website ([artandthegreathunger.org](http://artandthegreathunger.org)).
- Recognition in the museum's annual report.
- One copy of the *Coming Home: Art and the Great Hunger* catalogue.
